

Manuscript Guidelines

Zeitschrift für Geistiges Eigentum (ZGE) - Intellectual Property Journal (IPJ)

1. Title:

Articles are to be headed by a title with the first name(s) and surname of the author underneath. Mention of academic title is not to be made.

2. Subheadings:

Articles are to be divided by subheadings. These are to be marked when necessary by Roman or Arabic numerals and lower-case letters set in round brackets. Further sub-division should be avoided.

3. List of Subheadings/Literature

No list is necessary.

4. Footnotes:

Articles are to include consecutively numbered footnotes. No endnotes are required.

5. Highlights:

Highlights and authors' names contained in the text are to be set in *italics*.

6. References

References within the text should be indicated by the subheading characters and not the page number. References to other footnotes which do not change are however possible.

7. Abbreviations

For German abbreviations, please refer to Kirchner/Butz's "Abkürzungsverzeichnis der Rechtsprache".

8. Source Citation:

Please follow the citation style of the respective work when compiling the list of references.

9. Data:

The electronic version of the article is to be sent by e-mail to one of the editors before being sent on to the publisher.

10. Addresses:

Please include the full postal address for the sending of galley proofs.

11. Book Reviews:

Footnotes are not necessary in reviews. The books in question are to be listed as in the example below:

The reviewer's name and academic title is to be given at the end of the review.
